Committee Reports

- Kentuckiana Cluster Dog Show Chair (Dianne O'Regan):

 - The judges for 2019 KSSC Speciality are Lisa and Lloyd Graser (Blue Heaven's Shetland Sheepdogs). These judges *may be shared* with Evansville, Mid-Kentucky, and Louisville Kennel Club.
 - Raffle Discussed. Name will be changed. Jen has two large baskets to donate.
 - 2020 Judges: Meredith & Hector. Airfare will be expensive from FT. Lauderdale, FL.
 - New Tax Laws that were passed will affect our show in 2019.
 - AKC status for club education requirements have been met for 2019.
- Calendar Chair (Jim McCabe): There are two calendars remaining. (One sold to Kathy Dodge.)
- ASSA/AKC Liaison (Jim McCabe): Discussed health information received on communicative diseases prevention/transmission. Some can be transmitted to humans, some between dogs. Most vulnerable are

young/old and those with suppressed immune system. Stressed importance of vet exams when signs of distress occurs. Next meeting will report on usage of Neosporin.

- Membership Chair (Kerry Begley): Read the applications for new members Margaret “Peg” Angel and Kathleen Dodge. KSSC members approved their acceptance into the club by acclamation.
- Constitution/Bylaws Review and Revision: Chair Linda Carden was unable to be present so committee member Jen McMakin discussed structures, protocol, and procedures, alignment with AKC. & ASSA. Suggestions from members are being taken through the website. Also there is a Special Called Meeting on November 10, at 2 p.m. at the J’town Library for the members to review the changes, ask questions and make additional suggestions. Voting on the revisions will be Sunday, December 16 at Marks Feed Store in Fern Creek at our Christmas Party Meeting.
- Health: We still need a volunteer for this position.

The special called meeting was brought to order at 2:00 at the Jeffersontown Public Library by President, Jen McMakin who reminded us that the purpose of this called meeting is to introduce the proposed updates of our Constitution and Bylaws to the membership, and to give members the opportunity to discuss the suggested changes, and to give feedback to the committee. No other business will be discussed during this meeting.

She then turned the meeting over to Linda Carden, Constitution & Bylaws Review and Revision Committee Chair, who detailed the committee's process over the previous three months:

- Requesting suggestions and feedback from the membership
- Identifying issues and problems with the 1991 document and current practices of the club
- Developing generalized solutions to those
- Writing actual language for the revised document

Opportunities for questions and discussion were given throughout.

Next the members received a draft version of the document with new or changed language in red, strikethrough for language being changed, and notations in a side side column with the source or reason for the change. Discussion and questions were encouraged.

Three suggestions for refinement that came from the discussions were:

- How do we describe our club's geographical area and should it not be included all mentions of meeting locations?
- Suggestion to expand the suggested title *Member at Large* to *Board Member at Large* for clarity.
- Can we allow for a way for the club to decide if a member should be suspended from KSSC when they have been suspended from any other animal organizations than AKC and ASSA?

These were all referred back to the committee for modification in the final language. The final document will be sent to members no later than December 1.

Meeting was adjourned by the President at 4:30.
